ORDINANCE NO. 2022 -0/

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF JIM THORPE, CARBON COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA AMENDING THE VEHICLE AND TRAFFIC ORDINANCE AND THE STREETS AND SIDEWALKS ORDINANCE FOR THE BOROUGH OF JIM THORPE.

WHEREAS, the Borough of Jim Thorpe has adopted a Borough Code including Chapter 420 regarding vehicles and traffic and Chapter 383 regarding streets and sidewalks; and,

WHEREAS, the Borough Council wishes to amend said ordinance.

NOW THEREFORE, the Borough Council of Jim Thorpe Borough hereby enacts and ordains as follows:

1. Section 420-4 regarding parking violations and penalties is hereby amended to read as follows:

Any person who shall violate any provision of this Article shall be subject to the penalties set forth in Section 420-21.B(2).

2. Section 420-8 shall be amended to read as follows:

Any person who shall violate the provisions of this Article shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$30.00, and cost of prosecution, and in default of payment of fines and costs, to imprisonment in the County Jail for not more than ten days.

- 3. Section 420-21(B)(1) and (2) shall be amended as follows:
- (1) Where the parking violation has to do with the parking in the parking kiosk zone, the sum of \$20.00 within 48 hours after the time of the notice, the sum of \$25.00 when such payment is made more than 48 hours but not more than five days after the time of the notice, or the sum of \$30.00 when such payment is made more than five days but less than 10 days after the time of the notice enclosed with the envelope provided, at the Borough Police Department or any of the special parking fine boxes

installed in various locations within the Borough within the time limit. Payment will save the violator from prosecution and from payment of the fine prescribed in §420-22 of this article; or

(2) In the case of all parking violations other than a parking kiosk violation, the sum of \$30.00 within 48 hours after the time of the notice, or the sum of \$35.00 when such payment is made more than 48 hours but not more than five days after the time of the notice, or the sum of \$40.00 when such payment is made more than five days but not more than 10 days after the time of the notice enclosed within the envelope provided, at the Borough Police Department or any of the special parking fine boxes installed in various locations within the Borough of Jim Thorpe within that time limit. Payment will save the violator from prosecution and from payment of the fine prescribed in § 420-22 of this article.

4. Section 420-25C shall be amended to read as follows:

Any person who shall violate the provisions of this Article shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$30.00, and cost of prosecution, and in default of payment of fines and costs, to imprisonment in the County Jail for not more than ten days.

5. Section 420-26B shall be amended to read as follows:

Any person who shall violate the provisions of this Article shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$30.00, and cost of prosecution, and in default of payment of fines and costs, to imprisonment in the County Jail for not more than ten days.

6. Section 420-27F shall be amended to read as follows:

Any person who violates any provisions of this Section shall, subject to the penalties set forth in Section 420-21B2.

7. Section 420- 28B shall be amended to read as follows:

Any person who shall violate the provisions of this Article shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$30.00, and cost of prosecution, and in default of payment of fines and costs, to imprisonment in the County Jail for not more than ten days.

Section 383-25 shall be amended to read as follows:

8. With the exception of those penalties provided in § 383-24E, any person who shall violate any provision of this article shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine not to exceed \$30.00 and costs. Each day that a violation continues shall constitute a separate offense.

In all other respects, the Borough Code shall remain the same and in full force and effect.
