Due to the ongoing Coronavirus pandemic, Jim Thorpe Borough will continue to be functioning with limited operations until further notice. We will continue to monitor and re-evaluate our operations. 3. Borough public works will refrain from all non-emergency interaction with the public.

4. All customers are encouraged to pay their utility bill by:

5. All property owners are encouraged to pay their Real Estate Tax Payments (check or money order only, no cash payments) by:

- b. Utility Drop Box at the front of Borough Hall

If a receipt is desired, include a self-addressed, stamped envelope and the receipt copy of your bill, with your payment.

6. No permit applications are being accepted until further notice. (with the exception of emergency work, as determined by the Borough)

7. No zoning or building inspections for construction projects will be completed until further notice.

8. All Borough Council Work Session meetings are cancelled until further notice. Borough Council Monthly Meetings will he held as scheduled FOR ESSENTIAL ITEMS ONLY. Please see the website for a draft of the agenda for the upcoming meeting. Call the office with any questions. No action or discussion will take place on non-essential items.

9. All other public meetings are cancelled until further notice.
