COVID-19 UPDATE May 10, 2021

Due to the ongoing Coronavirus pandemic, Jim Thorpe Borough continues to monitor and reevaluate our operations moving forward. We will continue to encourage social distancing during this time, especially in the Borough parks. Please see below for updates to the Borough's operations.

Below are some of the steps the borough has put in place:

- 1. Essential services such as Police, Fire and Public Works will remain operational.
- 2. Borough Hall and Police Station Service Window will open to the public on Monday, May 10, 2021. Social Distancing guidelines will be followed. Masks remain mandatory. Bring hand sanitizer for your use.
- 3. Utility bills may be paid by:
 - a. In Person
 - b. USPS Mail
 - c. Utility Drop Box at the front of Borough Hall (No Cash Payments)
 - d. Credit Card online at www.jtborough.org
 - e. Mauch Chunk Trust Company
 - f. Jim Thorpe Neighborhood Bank
- 4. The Borough Tax Collector is holding office hours on **Tuesdays**, **11:00** am **to 7:00** pm in the Borough office. **Saturdays May 22 & 29; Sept 18 & 25 9:00** am **to 12:00** pm.
- 5. Real Estate Tax Payments (check* or money order only, no cash payments) may continue to be paid by:
 - a. In person during Tax Collector Hours
 - b. Tax Collector Drop Box in Borough Office during Administration office hours
 - c. Mail to Patricia Spillman, 92 West Broadway, Jim Thorpe, PA 18229
 - d. Utility Drop Box at the front of Borough Hall

If a receipt is desired, include a self-addressed, stamped envelope and the receipt copy of your bill, with your payment.

- 6. Borough Parks are open. CDC guidelines and PA Dept of Health guidelines should be followed at all times. Bring sanitizer and disinfectant wipes for your use.
- 7. Borough Water & Sewer Plants and Borough Garage remain closed to the public until further notice. Telephone numbers are listed at the end of this notice.
- 8. All Borough meetings will continue to follow the State, PA Dept of Health and CDC guidelines. Public Comment may continue to be submitted in writing via USPS, email (secretary@jtborough.org) or placed in the drop box at the Borough Office. We encourage you to submit comments early so we may make appropriate copies and distribute in adequate time for the council, commissions, or boards to be able to review as necessary.
