

Upcoming PennDOT Projects in the Downtown Area

Below is information we have at this time on these projects:

Broadway/West Broadway

- ❖ Susquehanna Street to High Street
- ❖ Sidewalk handicap curb cuts and paving
- ❖ Monday through Friday, 7:00 am to 5:00 pm

PennDOT will be completing new curb cuts for handicap accessibility on sidewalks beginning Wednesday, March 6, 2019.

Milling and paving will take place in April, once the asphalt plants open for the season. There will be no parking on the street during this phase with traffic down to one lane while milling and paving is being completed. After hours, parking and traffic lanes will return to normal.

Mansion House Hill Rockface Project

- ❖ SR 209, JT Borough line to approximately the high point of SR209 on Mansion House Hill
- ❖ Rock slide mitigation, roadway drainage improvements and other miscellaneous construction
- ❖ 8:30 am to 3:00 pm

Anticipated start date is mid-April.

Right lane (northbound) SR209 adjacent to the rock face is permitted to remain closed 24 hours per day for the duration of the project.

In the interest of public safety, a full closure of all travel lanes, including bicycles and pedestrians, on SR 209 from just south of Oak Drive to just north of the Highland Beverage Parking Lot is required for rock scaling, debris removal, and clearing of vegetation during the hours of 8:30 am to 3:00 pm, Monday through Friday, except for the weeks of July 2-6, the Friday and Monday of Labor Day Weekend, the Monday of Columbus Day Weekend, the Thursday and Friday of Thanksgiving Weekend, and the weeks of Christmas and New Year. Flaggers will be available for emergency vehicle access.

Truck restrictions will be placed on Flagstaff Road.

The traffic controls for this project will be essentially similar to those in place for the emergency repairs completed in 2018.
