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# SIGN-UP INFORMATION

Throughout the years the Jim Thorpe Rotary Summer Camp has continued to provide a safe and exciting camp for students within the Jim Thorpe Area School District. However, due to the continual rise of basic items to keep the Summer Camp funded and running appropriately we will be implementing a charge per camper. The charge per camper will be \$50.00 for the entire 8 weeks. We understand the financial burden that has been placed on families with continual costs rising. Therefore, you may decide to pay the fee before camp begins by mailing in a check to: JT Rotary Summer Recreation, PO BOX 103, Jim Thorpe, PA 18229. If you choose to pay before camp begins please include your child's name with the check.

However, if you are unable to pay for the cost of camp before, upon the first day your child arrives you may pay the fee via check or cash.

\*Please do not send money until you are accepted into Summer Camp\*

If you need any additional assistance or have questions please do not hesitate to reach out!

#### INFORMATION ON REOPENING

- Camp will be limited this year to 125 campers. First to fill out the online registration.
  - \*Applications will NOT be accepted via paper copy. \*
- An email will be sent within ONE week stating if your camper is eligible for the camp or not.
- Sign ups will close June 16, 2024 or once 125 campers is reached.
- The link for Sign Ups will be posted on May 1st at 7:00am.
- The link will be posted on the Jim Thorpe Rotary Summer Camp Facebook page as well as the Jim Thorpe Borough Website.
- Campers must bring their own water bottles.
- Upon dropping your camper off the first day, a parent/guardian will have to fill out TWO liability forms.
  - -One for the Jim Thorpe Rotary
  - -One for the Jim Thorpe Area School District

#### **PROCEDURES**

#### Drop Off:

- Please DO NOT drop your camper off before 8:30 as no counselor will be on property.
- Please report to the side doors of the L.B Morris to sign your camper in.
- Parents/Guardians are <u>REQUIRED</u> to sign your camper in <u>DAILY</u>.
   \*Failure to do this and your camper will be
  - \*Failure to do this and your camper will be removed from the camp.



- Pick Up time is 3:00
- Upon pick up parents must come to the side doors of the L.B. Morris to sign their camper out.
  - \* An ID is required **DAILY** to sign your camper out.
- If a camper is going home with a friend or another relative a note <u>MUST</u> be provided during drop off.

#### REMIND APP

• Please utilize the Summer Camp's Remind App daily. This app is utilized to communicate with parents daily. By using this app the Director and Co-Director will be alerted for drop off, pick up, and other related issues.

- Campers must be currently enrolled in the Jim Thorpe Area School District.
- Camp is for students in 1st-5th grade.
- Campers are **NOT** allowed to leave camp without a counselor.
- Campers are NOT allowed to sign in or out themselves.
- JTSDC- is a bully free zone.
- Campers must eat lunch in the cafe during appropriate times (12pm-12:40pm) and must remain there until dismissed.
- JTSDC- in not responsible for lost or broken items. If your camper brings their phone to camp it is their responsibility.
- NO bicycles, scooters, or skateboards are allowed in L.B Morris.
- Campers must cooperate and participate in camp activities.
- Cursing/ foul language, hurtful, or offensive language will not be tolerated or accepted at the camp.
- NO weapons or toys that resemble weapons.
- JTSDC has the right to terminate a campers eligibility from the Summer Camp at any time for violating any rules.

# WRITE UP PROCEDURES

- If at any time a camper is unable to follow the rules of the JTSDC established on page 4 a write up will occur.
- A campers parent will be contacted and a referral paper will be given regarding the write up
  - After 2 write ups a camper will be suspended from Summer Camp for 1 week.
  - If a camper were to receive a third write up the camper will be suspended from Summer Camp for the remainder of the Summer.
    - At any time JTSDC has the right to permanently remove a camper for bullying, fighting, cursing, etc.

#### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- Camp this year will take place from June 17-August 8 = 8 weeks
- Summer Camp is for students in 1st-5th grade enrolled within the JTASD.
- Camp will run from Monday-Thursday(8:30-3:00).
- There will be **NO** camp on Fridays
- Camp will be closed on July 4th and will reopen July 8th.
- We can not accept food items that are not individually wrapped.
- Donations are accepted to help with funds of running the Summer Camp.

## LUNCHES

Lunch will be provided daily.

Parents and Guardians are still able to pack a lunch for their child if they wish as well.

The items for lunches that will be provided throughout the Summer Camp will be either hot or cold. All lunches will be healthy for campers.

Peanut Products are not allowed at camp due to allergies!

A drink of milk WILL be included for lunch.
